

CASE No. 9136 – Constellation Power Source Generation – CPCN to Modify the Perryman Generating Station in Harford County

Request for CPCN to modify the existing Perryman Plant, which now has four oil-fired combustion turbines (“CT’s”) and one oil or natural gas-fired CT, to add ten dual-fuel simple-cycle CT units. The result would be to add 600 Megawatts of nominal generating capacity to the existing 355 Megawatts of nominal generating capacity.

OPC is a party in the case. PPRP has taken the position that the new CT’s should be evaluated as construction of additional generating capacity, not a modification of existing generating capacity. The evidentiary and public hearings were initially scheduled for September 26, 2008, but the hearings have been delayed due to requests by PPRP for further information from the applicant on the adequacy of ground water allocations for the facility. OPC does expect to participate in the hearings, and is monitoring the information on ground water allocations to determine whether this may be a concern to residential and noncommercial customers in Harford County.
